



- e) Install all door frames within wall systems. This includes pressed steel and PC-350 door frames in drywall partitions, and pocket sliding door frames as per the DRAWINGS and SPECIFICATIONS
- f) For rated wall assemblies, include fire stop insulation, and fire stop caulking, to seal top and all penetrations, to meet City requirements and as per the DRAWINGS and SPECIFICATIONS
- g) Provide for all walls including steel stud, drywall, insulation, and finish taping, mud, and sanding ready for paint as per the DRAWINGS and SPECIFICATIONS
- h) Provide all ceiling materials as required and as per the DRAWINGS and SPECIFICATIONS (T-Bar, drywall, and bulkheads as required).
- i) As required, repair all drywall/plaster identified as existing and required to remain, as per the DRAWINGS and SPECIFICATIONS
