

PART 1 General

1.1 CONTRACT DOCUMENTS

- .1 This Addendum forms an integral part of the Contract Documents, describing all aspects of the Work and is to be read in conjunction herewith. This document is to be read in conjunction with the drawings and specifications and shall be recognized as a Contract Document. If points arise which are at variance, this Addendum shall take precedence, unless otherwise clarified by the Architect. This Addendum shall be returned with the other bid documents

1.2 ACKNOWLEDGEMENT

- .1 The Bidder is responsible for signifying they have received this Addendum by listing the Addendum number and date in the appropriate space on the Tender Form.

PART 2 BIDDING DOCUMENTS AND GENERAL REQUIREMENTS

2.1 Bid Requirements

- .1 Refer to the Centre d'excellence en approvisionnement FRANCOachat for all clarification in the bid process.

2.2 Product Requirements

- .1 Specific materials, products and systems specified in the Contract Documents provide a Standard of Acceptance. Equivalent materials, products or systems by other manufacturers are acceptable as substitutions, provided that the properties and compliances of the substitutions:
 - .1 Meet or exceed the properties and compliances of the specified materials, products and systems in all respects and
 - .2 All items exposed to sight are of the same appearance as the specified items.
- .2 Bidders wishing to submit alternatives for material, product or equipment specified must do so during the tender period, allowing time for review before Tender Close. The Client shall be under no obligation to accept alternative products after the Tender Close, except for extenuating circumstances such as discontinuation of products or materials.

 - .1 **Add** items 2.1.2.9 to read 'The panels may be fabricated or be provided by the Acceptable Manufacturer: Armstrong, TECTUM Blades and Baffles; to the specifications above.'
- .4 Section 09 80 00 – Acoustical Treatment, Item 2.1.3.7.
 - .1 **Delete** 'Wall mounted' and Replace with 'Ceiling Suspended'.

 - .1 Gridline 6, **Delete** Reference 'GB-01' (for wall mounted acoustical panels) and **Replace** with '**AP-03**'. Refer to specifications for acoustical units with three colours shown on legend in detail 9/500.

 - .1 Question: 'it would be very helpful if all finishes were organized into a standard finish schedule. These are typical for this kind of project and should be at the start of the Section 9 specs'.
 - .2 Response: Documents are arranged for best Contract documentation and integration of specifications. No changes to the Contract Documents.
